
Greetings!

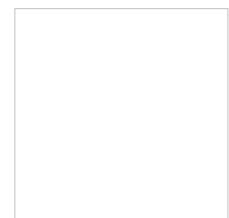
